

Cancelled Mobility at School of Medicine of the University of Cádiz for the Academic Year 2020/2021

Dear students,

It is hopeful and we are glad to see that, despite the difficult times we are going through, many of our students are still motivated to take up our fruitful European Erasmus mobility Program.

It is evident that the current situation, in Spain, in relation to COVID, does not allow us to speak of a 100% controlled situation. Day after day new news of "sprouts" appear. Given this situation, the Government of the Junta de Andalucía, has ordered **the suspension of practices by professionals or foreign students in the Andalusian Public Health System**. This order will be kept until new order from the health authorities.

That does not allow us to guarantee short or medium term plans. From the Faculty of Medicine of Cádiz we are not in favor of offering provisional plans that are constantly under the threat of being canceled or modified depending on the development, day by day, of this situation.

Under these circumstances, I must inform you that In order to be able to contribute to a reduction in the appearance of sprouts of SARS CoV-2 in the best possible way, the School of Medicine of Cadiz has decided **to suspend all international mobility during the entire 2020-2021 academic year**.

For this reason, all Learning Agreements that have already been signed are canceled.

Our International Relations Office is preparing an official document to inform to all partners.

These are difficult times when we have to make painful decisions.

I hope that for the 21-22 course we can return to normality.
